May 3, 2025 Bond Election Results

Unofficial results from Travis County Elections Division for the May 3, 2025 bond election, shows voters gave approval to the District to pursue bonds for continued improvements within the District. Voters passed the \$13.6 million bond authorization for much needed improvements to infrastructure of the water, wastewater and drainage in Point Venture. The preliminary results showed 87.38% of voters voting for the bond.

This decision showed residents and property owners understood the importance of passing a bond to fund needed improvement projects. The District must comply to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) rules to remain in compliance and avoid problems. The District will now proceed with next steps to issue the bonds to provide the funds necessary for the following

projects:

- Replace Augusta standpipe (in engineering stage)
- Improve system waterlines for added fire flow and demand
- Rehabilitate a transfer pump station and elevated water storage tank
- Improve water and sewer lines
- Improve reclaimed water and drainage

The District is required to hold a meeting for the purpose of considering Board approval of an order canvassing returns and declaring results of the bond election. This special meeting is scheduled on Monday, May 12 at 3:00 p.m. in the District's office, 18606 Venture Drive, Point Venture.
