Next Two Monthly Board Meetings to be Held Early

PV Still in Stage 2 - Mandatory Outdoor Watering Restrictions

Even with the most welcomed recent rains and a slight rise in Lakes Buchanan and Travis, Point Venture remains in Stage 2 - Mandatory Watering Restrictions of its Drought Contingency Plan (DCP).

Rainfall all along the watershed of the Highland Lakes resulted in the addition of much needed water into Lake Travis. Some places recorded upward of 8 inches. The District recorded 5.6 inches of rain in October. Residential customers may water their yard twice a week on assigned days from Midnight to 10 a.m. and from 7 p.m. to midnight. Odd number addresses may water Wednesdays and Saturdays. Even number address may water Thursdays and Sundays.

Commercial customers may water landscapes on Tuesdays and Fridays during the same times as stated above.

Thank you for continuing to conserve water.

Updates to Projects in the District

- 1) The Generator was delivered and installed at the Water Treatment Plant (WTP). The last piece of equipment needed for the generator to be operational is the installation of an Automatic Transfer Switch. This is expected to be installed before the end of the year providing power backup to the WTP before the freeze season begins.
- 2) The District, our engineering team, Trihydro, and our operations team, Inframark, met with the contractor Associated Construction Partners (ACP) that is contracted to build the new Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP). ACP is busy planning the construction process and are scheduled to have "boots on the ground" on or around December 10, 2023.
